



eHomewise v5.3.8 installation instructions

1. Unzip eHomewise_v5.3.X.zip and upload the ehomewise folder to your server.
2. You should rename the ehomewise folder before you make any changes to the site settings. Do not change this after your site is active.
3. Open inc_conn.asp with a text editor and modify the following lines.

(This is the path to your database. We recommend you move your database to a secure location other than the db folder)

```
strDatabasePath = "c:\inetpub\wwwroot\ehomewise\db\"
```

4. Have your host assign Modify permissions to the db and uploads folder and all subdirectories in those folders.
5. Login to the admin control panel using the following info.

6. Modify the following info and click submit. After you click submit you should be able to modify other settings and start using your site.

7. We recommend you modify your email settings next before you continue using your site.
8. Once you are logged into your site you should also change the rc4code in the inc_conn.asp file. You should use at least 10 letters and numbers. You also must be logged in and be on the Update Administrator Login page or you passwords will not function. As soon as you change your key and save the page you should change your password for the admin login. If you have problems you should contact support and we will send you a password retrieval file.
